Purpose of the Post

- 1. In conjunction with the existing medical team to provide service delivery to the Inpatient Unit, Day Hospice and Outpatients Departments.
- 2. Under the supervision of the Consultant in Palliative Medicine/ Associate Specialist/ Director of Patient Services to participate in audit, research and education.
- 3. To further develop knowledge and skills in the principles and practice of Palliative Care by developing:
 - A sound knowledge of symptom control
 - A knowledge of psychosocial aspects of care of patients with advanced disease
 - The concept of teamwork within the multi-professional team
 - Communication and counselling skills
 - An understanding of the bereavement process.

Duties of the Post

- 1. To admit patients to the hospice and plan their care.
- 2. To undertake regular medical review of patients, to attend multidisciplinary meetings and outpatient clinics.
- 3. To plan future admissions with the IPU team.
- 4. To undertake, when appropriate, medical review of patients discharged from the ward in outpatients.
- 5. To undertake, when required, to see new patients in the Day Hospice, to plan their care and follow-up.
- 6. To attend the Day Hospice multidisciplinary meetings and provide appropriate medical support for day care patients as required.
- 7. To liaise with other members of the multi-professional team, families, Primary Health Care Teams, Hospital Services and other Specialist Palliative Care services in the delivery of patient care.
- 8. To undertake domiciliary and hospital consultations with appropriate supervision as required.
- 9. To keep accurate records and, when required, complete patient letters.
- 10. To participate in audit, research and education programme.
- 11. To participate in the on-call rota as agreed.
- 12. To identify training and development opportunities in conjunction with the Associate Specialist/DPS and Consultant in Palliative Care and participate in personal training as may be necessary to meet the duties and responsibilities of the post.
- 13. To fulfill the requirements of appraisal and continuing professional development (CPD).
