1. Welcome

Dr Thomas welcomed everyone to the meeting.

2. Apologies

3. Matters Arising

- Paper notes Patient notes are away being back-scanned this week, so this information will be now held electronically by practices, there is a process with NHS Orkney to ensure data quality. The group wondered if these notes are stored for a period before destruction. Discussed the wider use of data by NHS Scotland.
- Newsletter The group suggested including information around patients not attending appointments, not phoning before 9am if not urgent and ordering prescriptions.
- **Test Results** Don't think that there is anything further that the practice can do in relation to increased sharing of results with patients until there is a technological solution to support this.

4. PSA testing

The practice does not offer routine screening as there is not a national PSA screening programme.

5. Sepsis

A group member had enquired regarding what people should be looking out for. Dr Thomas showed a scorecard for assessing signs of sepsis. Clinicians try to advise patients on what to do if symptoms get worse

6. Practice Update

- Patient access programme Lorraine told the group about a project the practice is working on with the assistance of Health Improvement Scotland. They will review current processes and consider how they can improve access to appointments for patients. The practice has been working on gathering data and has a meeting arranged for tomorrow.
